Weather/Skywarn Outlook

A frontal system is expected to develop across the area later this week. This front will bring good chances of rain and wind gusts from 25-30 mph, starting Monday night through Tuesday with daily highs staying near 60. Colder air filtering in behind the front may result in the rain changing over to snow or a wintry mix from Tuesday night into Thursday night. Accumulating snow is possible at that time. Daily high temps will hang out in the mid to upper 30's through Sunday.
