Weather/Skywarn Outlook

Fog possible Monday evening. Accumulating snow is possible towards the middle of the week, around Wednesday into Thursday with colder temperatures. Temps will rebound and return to highs in the upper 30's/lower 40's for the weekend with some rain.

A storm system is expected to move through the Ohio Valley around Wednesday into Thursday. This system has the potential to bring a wintry mix of precipitation to the area. Accumulating snow is possible during this time frame. Colder air moving in behind the system may allow for wind chills to fall to near zero degrees late Thursday night.

Although NWS may request spotter activity concerning the winter weather threat later in the week, Amateur Radio activation is not likely. As always be weather aware.
